Pursuant to delegation by the Commission, see 37 Fed. Reg. 28,710 (Dec. 29, 1972), and the Commission's regulations, see 10 C.F.R. §§ 2.105, 2.300, 2.303, 2.309, 2.313, 2.318, 2.321, notice is hereby given that an Atomic Safety and Licensing Board (Board) is being established to preside over the following proceeding:

CROW BUTTE RESOURCES, INC.
(Marsland Expansion Area)

This proceeding involves a request from Crow Butte Resources, Inc. to amend its Source Material License, SUA-1534, to obtain authority to construct and operate an in situ uranium recovery satellite facility at its Marsland site in Dawes County, Nebraska. In response to a "Notice of Opportunity for a Hearing" published in the Federal Register, see 77 Fed. Reg. 71,454 (Nov. 30, 2012), hearing requests were filed on January 29, 2013 by (1) the Oglala Sioux Tribe, and (2) a consolidated group of petitioners comprised of Antonia Loretta Afraid of Bear Cook, Bruce McIntosh, Debra White Plume, Western Nebraska Resources Council, and Aligning for Responsible Mining.
