The Committee will review proposals submitted to NSF under the purview of the Office of International and Integrative Activities (OIIA). The Committee will review and evaluate proposals, which may include site visits, and provide written recommendations on proposals as part of the selection process for awards. The Committee may evaluate and provide advice on the progress of awarded proposals.
