By Notice dated August 17, 2012, and published in the Federal Register on August 20, 2012, 77 FR 50162, Clinical Supplies Management, Inc., 342 42<sup>nd</sup> Street South, Fargo, North Dakota 58103, made application by renewal to the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) to be registered as an importer of the basic classes of controlled substances:

Sufentanil (9740)	II

The company plans to import the listed controlled substances for packaging, labeling, and distributing to customers which are qualified clinical sites, conducting FDA-approved clinical trials.

The import of the above listed basic classes of controlled substances would be granted only for analytical testing and clinical trials. This authorization does not extend to the import of a finished FDA approved or non-approved dosage form for commercial distribution in the United States.

No comments or objections have been received. DEA has considered the factors in 21 USC § 823(a) and § 952(a) and determined that the registration of Clinical Supplies Management, Inc., to import the basic class of controlled substance is consistent with the public interest and with United States obligations under international treaties, conventions, or protocols in effect on May 1, 1971. DEA has investigated Clinical Supplies Management, Inc., to ensure that the company's registration is consistent with the public interest. The investigation has included inspection and testing of the company's physical security systems, verification of the company's compliance with state and local laws, and a review of the company's background and history.

Therefore, pursuant to 21 USC § 952(a) and § 958(a), and in accordance with 21 CFR § 1301.34, the above named

company is granted registration as an importer of the basic class of controlled substance listed.
