This report is necessary to establish qualifications of eligibility to receive voluntary physiological training with the US Air Force and will be used as proper evidence of training. The information is collected from pilots and crewmembers for application to receive voluntary training.

Respondents: An estimated 5,500 pilots and crewmembers.

Frequency: Information is collected on occasion.

Estimated Average Burden per Response: 8 minutes.

Estimated Total Annual Burden: 733 hours.
