SUMMARY: The Department of the Navy hereby gives notice of its intent to grant to VIC Technology Venture Development, LLC a revocable, nonassignable, exclusive license to practice in the field of use of assistive devices for providing enhanced understanding of human speech for hearing-impaired individuals, for communication in acoustically noisy environments, for language interpretation, for voice control of other devices, and for security/surveillance applications in the United States, the Government-owned invention described in U.S. Patent Application No. 13/155,218: Radar Microphone Speech

Recognition, Navy Case No. 100,567 and any continuations, divisionals or re-issues thereof.
