Notice of Petition For Declaratory Order

Take notice that on August 20, 2014, Confederated Salish and Kootenai Tribes of the Flathead (CSKT) and SX□N□ E□ELS LSUW□ EČM / KSUK□I□MUMA□ □ A·K□ □A□MUKWA□ITS, Inc. (EKI), pursuant to Rules 205 and 207, and section 35.12 of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's (Commission) Rules of Practice and Procedure, 18 CFR 385.205, 385.207, and 35.12 and in accordance to Commission's Orders,<sup>1</sup> filed a petition for declaratory order requesting that the Commission find that CSKT and EKI are public utilities that are exempt under section 210(f) of Part II of the Federal Power Act, 16 U.S.C. 824(f) (2012), as more fully explained in its petition.

Any person desiring to intervene or to protest this filing must file in accordance with Rules 211 and 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 CFR 385.211, 385.214). Protests will be considered by the Commission in determining the appropriate action to be taken, but will not serve to make protestants parties to the proceeding. Any person wishing to become a party must file a notice of intervention or motion to intervene, as appropriate. Such notices, motions, or protests must be filed on or before the comment date. On or before the comment date, it is not necessary to serve motions to intervene or protests on persons other than the Applicant.

The Commission encourages electronic submission of protests and interventions in lieu of paper using the "eFiling" link at <http://www.ferc.gov>. Persons unable to file electronically should submit an original and 5 copies of the protest or intervention to the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, 888 First Street, NE, Washington, DC 20426.
