Notice of Petition for Declaratory Order

Take notice that on November 4, 2014, pursuant to Rule 207 of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's (Commission) Rules of Practice and Procedure, 18 CFR 385.207 (2014), Energy Producers and Users Coalition filed a petition for declaratory order finding that California Public Utilities Commission's approval<sup>1</sup> of as-available procurement options relying on short-run avoided cost pricing as part of the QF/CHP Settlement was an exercise of its authority under the Public Utilities Regulatory Policies Act.

Any person desiring to intervene or to protest this filing must file in accordance with Rules 211 and 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 CFR 385.211, 385.214). Protests will be considered by the Commission in determining the appropriate action to be taken, but will not serve to make protestants parties to the proceeding. Any person wishing to become a party must file a notice of intervention or motion to intervene, as appropriate. Such notices, motions, or protests must be filed on or before the comment date. Anyone filing a motion to intervene or protest must serve a copy of that document on the Petitioner.
