Extension of Public Comment Period for Application for Proposed Project for Clean Line Plains & Eastern Transmission Line

AGENCY: Office of Electricity Delivery and Energy Reliability, DOE.

ACTION: Extension of public comment period.

SUMMARY: The Department of Energy (DOE) published a Notice of Application for Proposed Project for Clean Line Plains & Eastern Transmission Line (80 Fed. Reg. 23520) requesting public comment on an application submitted by Clean Line Energy Partners, LLC under Section 1222 of the Energy Policy Act of 2005. DOE is extending the end of the public comment period on the application for the Clean Line Plains & Eastern Transmission Line from June 12 to July 13, 2015.

DATES: DOE extends the public comment period to July 13, 2015. Comments submitted to DOE concerning Clean Line's application prior to this announcement do not need to be resubmitted as a result of this extension of the comment period.
