Multilayered Wood Flooring from the People's Republic of China: Correction to the Final Results of Antidumping Duty Administrative Review

SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION: On July 15, 2015, the Department of Commerce (“Department”) published the final results of the 2012-2013 administrative review of the antidumping duty order on multilayered wood flooring from the People's Republic of China.¹ The period of review (“POR”) is December 1, 2012, through November 30, 2013. The Department is issuing this notice to correct an inadvertent error in the *Final Results*. Specifically, the Department initiated a review of Jianfeng Wood (Suzhou) Co., Ltd. (“Jianfeng”),² and the company listed in the *Final Results* is also Jianfeng, however, the record reflects that the correct company name, and the company to which the Department assigned a separate rate, is Jiafeng

Wood (Suzhou) Co., Ltd. (“Jiafeng”).³ Accordingly, we intended to include Jiafeng, not Jianfeng, in the list of companies that received a separate rate during the POR as identified in our *Final Results*.⁴

This correction to the final results of administrative review is issued and published in accordance with sections 751(h) and 777(i) of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended.
