ACTION: Temporary Exemption; issuance; correction.

SUMMARY: The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) is correcting a notice that was published in the *Federal Register* on July 24, 2015, that gave notice to the public that it is considering issuance of a temporary exemption from certain NRC financial assurance requirements to Lost Creek ISR, LLC, for its Lost Creek *In Situ* Recovery (ISSR) Project in Crook County, Wyoming.
