AGENCY: Department of Veterans Affairs.

ACTION: Notice to Delete System of Records.

SUMMARY: The Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) is deleting a system of records entitled "Center for Acquisition and Materiel Management Education Online (CAMEO) – VA" (111VA95E), which was established at 66 Fed. Reg. 43043, dated August 16, 2001. The purpose of CAMEO was to collect and maintain training and education data for VA's acquisition and material management work force. The system is now obsolete, and civilian agencies are required, as mandated by OMB, to use the Federal Acquisition Institute Training Application System (FAITAS) as their acquisition workforce system of records. FAITAS is owned and managed by GSA.
