Notice Of Petition For Declaratory Order

Take notice that on July 18, 2016, pursuant to rule 207 of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's (Commission) Rules of Practice and Procedure,¹ section 219 of the Federal Power Act,² and Order No. 679,³ Citizens Energy Corporation (Citizens or Petitioner), on behalf of itself and its wholly owned subsidiary Citizens Power Connect, LLC, filed a petition for a declaratory order requesting the Commission authorize two rate treatments in connection with a new high voltage transmission project that Citizens is partnering with Pacific Gas and Electric and MidAmerican Central California Transco, LLC., to develop and finance, all as more fully explained in the petition.

Any person desiring to intervene or to protest this filing must file in accordance with Rules 211 and 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 CFR 385.211 and 385.214). Protests will be considered by the Commission in determining the appropriate action to be taken, but will not serve to make protestants parties to the proceeding. Any person wishing to become a party must file a notice of intervention or motion to intervene, as appropriate. Such notices, motions, or protests must be filed on or before the comment date. Anyone filing a motion to intervene or protest must serve a copy of that document on the Petitioner.
