Agency Information Collection Activity: Study on Provision of Interments in Veterans' Cemeteries during Weekends

ACTION: Notice of cancellation

SUMMARY: In compliance with the Paperwork Reduction Act (PRA) of 1995, the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) National Cemetery Administration's (NCA) emergency notice announcing the "Study on Provision of Interments in Veterans' Cemeteries during Weekends," survey has been cancelled as of June 22, 2017. Public Law 114-315, section 304, enacted by the U.S. Congress and signed by the President on December 16, 2016, makes a specific request for the collection and reporting of the information covered by this request. NCA will be soliciting comments by posting questions to the general public through a Federal Register Notice.
