Notice Pursuant to the National Cooperative Research and  
Production Act of 1993 -- Opendaylight Project, Inc.

Notice is hereby given that, on July 26, 2017, pursuant to  
Section 6(a) of the National Cooperative Research and Production  
Act of 1993, 15 U.S.C. § 4301 et seq. ("the Act"), OpenDaylight  
Project, Inc. ("OpenDaylight") has filed written notifications  
simultaneously with the Attorney General and the Federal Trade  
Commission disclosing changes in its membership. The  
notifications were filed for the purpose of extending the Act's  
provisions limiting the recovery of antitrust plaintiffs to  
actual damages under specified circumstances. Specifically,  
Hewlett Packard, Palo Alto, CA; A10 Networks, San Jose, CA; KEMP  
Technologies, New York, NY; Microsoft Corporation, Redmond, WA;  
ClearPath Networks, El Segundo, CA; Versa Networks, Santa Clara,  
CA; Alcatel-Lucent Enterprise, Calabasas, CA; and SDN  
Essentials, Sunnyvale, CA, have withdrawn as parties to this  
venture.

No other changes have been made in either the membership or  
planned activity of the group research project. Membership in  
this group research project remains open, and OpenDaylight  
intends to file additional written notifications disclosing all  
changes in membership.

On May 23, 2013, OpenDaylight filed its original notification pursuant to Section 6(a) of the Act. The Department of Justice published a notice in the Federal Register pursuant to Section 6(b) of the Act on July 1, 2013 (78 FR 39326).

The last notification was filed with the Department on May 2, 2017. A notice was published in the Federal Register pursuant to Section 6(b) of the Act on June 7, 2017 (82 FR 26514).
