Notice of Determinations; Culturally Significant Objects Imported for Exhibition – Determinations: “Victorian Radicals: From the Pre-Raphaelites to the Arts & Crafts Movement” Exhibition

SUMMARY: Notice is hereby given of the following determinations: I hereby determine that certain objects to be included in the exhibition “**Victorian Radicals: From the Pre-Raphaelites to the Arts & Crafts Movement,**” imported from abroad for temporary exhibition within the United States, are of cultural significance. The objects are imported pursuant to a loan agreement with the foreign owner or custodian. I also determine that the exhibition or display of the exhibit objects at the **Oklahoma City Museum of Art**, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, from on or about October 11, 2018, until on or about January 6, 2019; at the **Vero Beach Museum of Art**, Vero Beach, Florida, from on or about February 9, 2019, until on or about May 5, 2019; at the **Seattle Art Museum**, Seattle, Washington, from on or about June 13, 2019, until on or about September 8, 2019; at the **San Antonio Museum of Art**, San Antonio, Texas, from on or about October 10, 2019, until on or about January 5, 2020; at the **Yale Center for British Art**, New Haven, Connecticut, from on or about February 13, 2020, until on or about May 10, 2020; at the **Nevada Museum of Art**, Reno, Nevada, from on or about June 20, 2020, until on or about September 13, 2020; at **The Frick Pittsburgh**, in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, from on or about October 29, 2020, until on or about January 24, 2021; and at possible additional exhibitions or venues yet to be determined, is in the national

interest. I have ordered that Public Notice of these determinations be published in the *Federal Register*.
