SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION: ACICBL provides advice and recommendations on policy and program development to the Secretary of HHS (Secretary) concerning the activities under Title VII, Part D of the Public Health Service Act, and is responsible for submitting an annual report to the Secretary and Congress describing the activities of the Committee, including findings and recommendations made by the Committee concerning the activities under Part D of

Title VII. ACICBL develops, publishes, and implements performance measures and guidelines for longitudinal evaluations and recommends appropriation levels for programs under this part. The charter renewal for the ACICBL was approved on March 15, 2019 and the filing date is March 24, 2019. Renewal of the ACICBL charter gives authorization for the Committee to operate until March 24, 2021.
