SUMMARY: The Charter for the Bureau of Economic Analysis Advisory Committee is renewed for an additional two-year period, as a necessary committee which is in the public interest, in accordance with the provisions of the Federal Advisory Committee Act (FACA), 5 U.S.C. App. 2.

SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION: The BEA Advisory Committee advises the Director of BEA on matters related to the development and improvement of BEA's national, regional, industry, and international economic accounts, with a focus on new and rapidly growing areas of the U.S. economy. The committee provides recommendations from the perspectives of academia, business, and government.

On June 7, 2019, the Secretary of Commerce approved the renewal of the BEA Advisory Committee charter. The new charter was made effective and filed with the appropriate Congressional committees and the Library of Congress on the same day. Renewal of the Committee's charter gives authorization for the Committee to continue to operate until June 7, 2021.
