**Notice of Determinations**

**Culturally Significant Object Imported for Exhibition – Determinations: “Alonso Berruguete: First Sculptor of Renaissance Spain” Exhibition**

**SUMMARY:** On September 5, 2019, notice was published on page 46772 of the *Federal Register* (volume 84, number 172) of determinations pertaining to certain objects to be included in an exhibition entitled “Alonso Berruguete: First Sculptor of Renaissance Spain.” Notice is hereby given of the following determinations: I hereby determine that certain additional objects to be exhibited in the exhibition “**Alonso Berruguete: First Sculptor of Renaissance Spain,**” imported from abroad for temporary exhibition within the United States, are of cultural significance. The objects are imported pursuant to loan agreements with the foreign owners or custodians. I also determine that the exhibition or display of the exhibit object at the **Meadows Museum, Southern Methodist University,** Dallas, Texas, from on or about March 29, 2020, until on or about July 26, 2020, and at possible additional exhibitions or venues yet to be determined, is in the national interest. I have ordered that Public Notice of these determinations be published in the *Federal Register*.
