Santa Ana Hollister (Formerly M.K. Ballistics) Removal Site, Hollister, CA; Notice of Proposed CERCLA Settlement Agreement for Recovery of Past Response Costs

AGENCY: Environmental Protection Agency (EPA).

ACTION: Notice; request for comment.

SUMMARY: In accordance with the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act of 1980, as amended (CERCLA), notice is hereby given of a proposed administrative settlement for recovery of response costs concerning the Santa Ana Hollister (Formerly M.K. Ballistics) Removal Site in Hollister, California. The settlement is entered into pursuant to Section 122(h)(1) of CERCLA, and it requires the settling parties to reimburse EPA \$121,500 in response costs that EPA incurred at the Site.

SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION: In accordance with Section 122(i) of the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act of 1980, as amended (CERCLA), 42 U.S.C. § 9622(i), notice is hereby given of a proposed administrative settlement for recovery of response costs concerning the Santa Ana Hollister (Formerly M.K. Ballistics) Removal Site in Hollister, California. The settlement is entered into pursuant to Section 122(h)(1) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9622(h)(1), and it requires the settling parties to reimburse EPA \$121,500 in response costs that EPA incurred at the Site. The settlement includes a covenant not to sue the settling parties pursuant to Sections 106 or 107(a) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. §§ 9606 or 9607(a). For thirty (30) days following the date of publication of this Notice in the Federal Register, the Agency will receive written comments relating to the settlement. The Agency will consider all comments received and may modify or withdraw its consent to the settlement if comments received disclose facts or considerations that indicate the proposed settlement is inappropriate, improper, or inadequate. The Agency's response to any comments received will be available for public inspection at 75 Hawthorne Street, San Francisco, CA 94105.
