Deseret Generation & Transmission Co-operative, Inc.; Notice of Petition for Partial Waiver

Take notice that on May 11, 2020, pursuant to section 292.402 of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's (Commission) Rules and Regulations,¹ Deseret Generation & Transmission Co-operative, Inc. (Deseret), on behalf of itself and its six (6) distribution cooperative member-owners (collectively, the Participating Members),² filed a petition for partial waiver of certain obligations imposed on Deseret and the Participating Members under sections 292.303(a) and 292.303(b) of the Commission's Regulations³ implementing section 210 of the Public Utility Regulatory Policies Act of 1978 (PURPA), as amended,⁴ all as more fully explained in the petition.

Any person desiring to intervene or to protest this filing must file in accordance with Rules 211 and 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 CFR 385.211, 385.214). Protests will be considered by the Commission in determining the appropriate action to be taken but will not serve to make protestants parties to the proceeding. Any person wishing to become a party must file a notice of intervention or motion to intervene, as appropriate. Such notices, motions, or protests must be filed on or before the comment date. Anyone filing a motion to intervene or protest must serve a copy of that document on the Petitioner.
