ACTION: Notice.

SUMMARY: The Assistant Secretary – Indian Affairs has made a final determination to acquire 10.36 acres, more or less, into trust for the Indians of the Tejon Indian Tribe.

DATES: The Assistant Secretary – Indian Affairs made the final determination on September 1, 2020.

On the date listed in the DATES section of this notice, the Assistant Secretary – Indian Affairs issued a decision to accept land in trust for the Tejon Indian Tribe under

the authority of the 25 U.S.C. 5108, Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 985).
