Written submissions may be made to the contact person on or before October 15, 2020. Oral presentations from the public will be scheduled between approximately 3:00 PM to 3:15 PM each day. Time allotted for each presentation may be limited. Those desiring to make formal oral presentations should notify the contact person and submit a brief statement of the general nature of the evidence or arguments they wish to present, the names and addresses of proposed participants, and an indication of the approximate time requested to make their presentation on or before October 15, 2020.
