Written comments or statements must be received by the DFO at least ten (10) calendar days prior to the meeting that is the subject of this notice. Written comments or statements received after this date may not be provided to or considered by the Air University Board of Visitors until its next meeting. The DFO will review all timely submissions with the Air University Board of Visitors' Board Chairperson and ensure they are provided to members of the Board before the meeting that is the subject of this notice.
