SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION: The purpose of the meeting is to:

1. Review provisions for Secure Rural Schools RAC to make recommendations on recreation fee proposals and Title II projects;
2. Discuss and make recommendations on recreation fee proposals for sites located on the Judith, Musselshell, White Sulphur, and Belt Creek Ranger Districts of the Helena-Lewis and Clark National Forest; and
3. Discuss and recommend new Title II projects.
