Commission Information Collection Activities; Request for Emergency Extension for FERC-725D

AGENCY: Federal Energy Regulatory Commission.

ACTION: Notice of request for an emergency extension.

SUMMARY: In compliance with the requirements of the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1995 (PRA), the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (Commission or FERC) has solicited public comments on FERC-725D (Mandatory Reliability Standard: Facilities Design, Connections and Maintenance Reliability Standards). FERC submitted a request to the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) for a three-month emergency extension (to March 31, 2021) to ensure this information collection will remain active while FERC completes the pending PRA renewal process. No changes are being made to the reporting and recordkeeping requirements.
