The objectives of this meeting are for the Monitoring Committee to: 1) Review recent stock assessment information, fishery performance, and recommendations from the Advisory Panel, the Scientific and Statistical Committee, and staff; 2) Recommend 2022-2023 commercial and recreational Annual Catch Limits, Annual Catch Targets, commercial quotas, and recreational harvest limits; 3) Review commercial management measures and recommend changes if needed;
