DCAA needs the data to continuously engage with potential leads who may not initially meet minimum qualification requirements; who may have applied/submitted a resume but were not selected; or who meet all requirements except having graduated from college. DCAA needs the data to conduct data analytics for outreach and recruitment return on investment assessments; to better refine outreach strategies, and to measure effectiveness of marketing and advertising efforts/campaigns.
