Filing a Motion to Intervene or Intervention is the procedural pathway to becoming a party in a proceeding at Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC). On October 25, 2023, Office of Public Participation (OPP) staff made publicly available the educational video of WorkshOPP: Fundamentals of Intervention in FERC Matters. Staff also addresses common questions about filing an intervention and demonstrate how to submit a Motion to Intervene using FERC online.
