**Bennett Landfill Fire Superfund Site, Chester, South Carolina; Proposed Settlements**

**AGENCY:** Environmental Protection Agency (EPA)

**ACTION:** Notice of proposed settlements.

**SUMMARY:** Under the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act (CERCLA), the United States Environmental Protection Agency is proposing to enter into individual settlements with three parties concerning the Bennett Landfill Fire Site located in Chester, South Carolina. The proposed settlements address recovery of CERCLA costs for a cleanup that was performed at the Site and costs incurred by EPA. The individual proposed settlements are as follows: Perrigo Company, CERCLA-04-2023-2530(b); Brookland Lakeview Empowerment Center, CERCLA-04-2023-2531(b); and Spartanburg County School District 4, CERCLA-04-2023-2534(b).

**DATES:** The Agency will consider public comments on the proposed settlements until **[INSERT DATE 30 DAYS AFTER DATE OF PUBLICATION IN THE FEDERAL REGISTER]**. The Agency will consider all comments received and may modify or withdraw its consent to the proposed settlements if comments received disclose facts or considerations which indicate that the proposed settlement is inappropriate, improper, or inadequate.
