Emergency Alert System; Wireless Emergency Alerts; Correction

AGENCY: Federal Communications Commission.

ACTION: Final rule; correction.

SUMMARY: This document corrects the **DATES** section of a final rule that appeared in the *Federal Register* on December 15, 2023, regarding the Wireless Emergency Alert system. This correction adds to the list of rules sections with indefinitely delayed effective dates.
