SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION: The Wreckfish Sub-Committee will discuss Amendment 48 to the Snapper Grouper Fishery Management Plan, select preferred alternatives, and consider approval for public hearings. Current actions under consideration in Amendment 48 include: sector allocations, electronic reporting, fishing

season, Individual Transferable Quota (ITQ) participation and eligibility requirements, fishery monitoring requirements, and cost recovery.
