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Advisory Committee on Reconciliation in Place Names; Charter Renewal

ACTION: Notice of charter renewal.

SUMMARY: The Secretary of the Interior is giving notice of the renewal of the Advisory Committee on Reconciliation in Place Names. The Committee identifies geographic feature names and Federal land unit names that are considered derogatory and solicits input on the process for generating replacement names.
