SUMMARY: The Commission will consider a Report and Order to create a voluntary cybersecurity labeling program for wireless consumer Internet of Things (IoT) products, which would help consumers make informed purchasing decisions, differentiate trustworthy products in the marketplace, and create incentives for manufacturers to meet higher cybersecurity

standards.

TITLE: Inquiry Concerning Deployment of Advanced Telecommunications Capability to All Americans in a Reasonable and Timely Fashion (GN Docket No. 22-270)

SUMMARY: The Commission will consider the draft 2024 Section 706 Report, which, if adopted, would fulfill the Commission's statutory responsibility under section 706 of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 and raise the fixed speed benchmark for advanced telecommunications capability to 100/20 Mbps.

TITLE: Single Network Future: Supplemental Coverage from Space (GN Docket No. 23-65); Space Innovation (IB Docket No. 22-271)

SUMMARY: The Commission will consider a Report and Order and Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking that would advance the Commission's vision for a single network future in which satellite and terrestrial networks work seamlessly together to provide coverage for consumer handsets that neither network can achieve on its own.
