#### Privacy Act of 1974; System of Records

**AGENCY:** Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC), Department of Energy (DOE).

**ACTION:** Rescindment of a system of records.

**SUMMARY:** Pursuant to the Privacy Act of 1974 and Office of Management and Budget (OMB) Circular No. A-108, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (Commission or FERC) proposes to rescind an existing system of records notice (SORN). Specifically, the following SORN is being proposed for rescindment “Commission Employee Performance Files (FERC – 38)”. The basis for rescindment is explained below.

**DATES:** Comments on this rescindment notice must be received no later than 30 days after the date of publication in the Federal Register. If no public comment is received during the period allowed for comment or unless otherwise published in the Federal Register by FERC, the rescindment will become effective a minimum of 30 days after the date of publication in the Federal Register. If FERC receives public comments, FERC shall review the comments to determine whether any changes to the notice are necessary.

**SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION:** “Commission Employee Performance Files (FERC – 38)” was identified for rescindment from FERC’s Privacy Act systems of records inventory because the system of records is duplicative, and the records are covered by a government-wide System of Records Notice (SORN). OMB requires that each agency provide assurance that system of records do not duplicate any existing agency or government-wide system of records. The Commission is rescinding this SORN because the records are covered by OPM/GOVT-2, Employee Performance File System Records, 87 FR 5874 (February 2, 2022).
