Self-Regulatory Organizations; Cboe BZX Exchange, Inc.; Cboe EDGX Exchange, Inc.; Cboe Exchange, Inc.; Cboe C2 Exchange, Inc.; Notice of Withdrawal of Proposed Rule Change to Adopt Cboe Timestamping Service

January 15, 2025.

On December 13, 2024, Cboe BZX Exchange, Inc., Cboe EDGX Exchange, Inc., Cboe Exchange, Inc., and Cboe C2 Exchange, Inc. (“Exchanges”) filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission (“Commission”), pursuant to Section 19(b)(1) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (“Act”)¹ and Rule 19b–4 thereunder,² proposed rule changes to adopt the Cboe Timestamping Service, which is a market data service comprised of two distinct market data reports. The proposed rule changes were immediately effective upon filing with the Commission pursuant to Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Act.³ On January 10, 2025, the Exchanges withdrew the proposed rule changes (SR-CboeBZX-2024-124; SR-CboeEDGX-2024-082; SR-CBOE-2024-056; SR-C2-2024-022).
