The meeting will convene at 11:00 a.m. and end at 2:30 p.m. Eastern Standard Time. This meeting is open to the public and will include time reserved for public comments at the end of the meeting. The public comment period will be 30 minutes. Individual stakeholders will be afforded three to five minutes to express their comments.

The purpose of NRAC is to advise the Secretary on research conducted by the Veterans Health Administration, including policies and programs targeting the high priority of Veterans' health care needs.

On March 5, 2025, the agenda will include presentations on 100 Years of VA Research; the VA Office of Research and Development Million Veteran Program, the ORD Annual Report, VA administration transition, an update on fiscal year (FY) 2024 NRAC Recommendation(s), the General Accountability Office (GAO) report on research protected time, and public comments.
