



Notice Pursuant to the National Cooperative Research and Production Act of 1993 -- Resilient Infrastructure + Secure Energy Consortium

Notice is hereby given that, on January 6, 2025, pursuant to section 6(a) of the National Cooperative Research and Production Act of 1993, 15 U.S.C. 4301 *et seq.* ("the Act"), Resilient Infrastructure + Secure Energy Consortium ("RISE") has filed written notifications simultaneously with the Attorney General and the Federal Trade Commission disclosing changes in its membership. The notifications were filed for the purpose of extending the Act's provisions limiting the recovery of antitrust plaintiffs to actual damages under specified circumstances. Specifically, Metropolitan Technologies, Ottawa, CANADA; Arctech Charge LLC, Draper, UT; OWL Integrations, Inc., Allentown, PA; Vertaeon LLC, Gainesville, FL; 3B Protection, Inc., Jupiter, FL; Xmark Labs LLC, Barrington, RI; Bishop Ascendant, Inc., Fairfield, NJ; Carolina Unmanned Vehicles, Raleigh, NC; Ecosystem Informatics USA Corp., Fort Worth, TX; Global Connective Center, Washington, DC; Simple Proof, Longmont, CO; TriTrack Motors, Georgetown, TX; UltraTech International, Inc., Jacksonville, FL; Varidx, Durham, NC; Sub Rosa Ventures, Orlando, FL; Phoenix Waste Solutions, Chauvin, LA; Mannik & Smith Group, Inc., Maumee, OH; Heliponix LLC, Evansville, IN; CipherSonic Labs, Inc., Cambridge, MA; Adapt Forward

LLC, North Charleston, SC; and Boomerang Aero Ventures, Lumberton, NJ, have been added as parties to this venture.

No other changes have been made in either the membership or planned activity of the group research project. Membership in this group research project remains open, and RISE intends to file additional written notifications disclosing all changes in membership.

On July 2, 2021, RISE filed its original notification pursuant to section 6(a) of the Act. The Department of Justice published a notice in the *Federal Register* pursuant to section 6(b) of the Act on August 23, 2021 (86 FR 47155).

The last notification was filed with the Department on October 2, 2024. A notice was published in the *Federal Register* pursuant to section 6(b) of the Act on December 2, 2024 (89 FR 95238).
