Proposal to Extend the Cultural Property Agreement between the United States and Costa Rica

SUMMARY: Proposal to extend the Memorandum of Understanding Between the Government of the United States of America and the Government of the Republic of Costa Rica Concerning the Imposition of Import Restrictions on Categories of Archaeological Material of Costa Rica (“the Costa Rica Agreement”).
