SUMMARY: The Pacific Fishery Management Council's (Pacific Council) Ad Hoc Sacramento River Fall Chinook (SRFC) Workgroup will hold a two-day online meeting.

DATES: The two-day online meeting will be held on Monday, June 30, 2025, from 10 a.m. until 3 p.m. Pacific Time or until business for the day concludes and Tuesday, July 1, 2025, from 9 a.m. until 3 p.m. Pacific Time or until business for the day concludes.
