SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION: On June 2, 2025, the Commission established a schedule for the conduct of the final phase of the subject investigations (90 FR 24665, June 11, 2025). The Commission is revising its schedule to address scheduling conflicts.

The Commission's revised dates in the schedule are as follows: the prehearing staff report will be placed in the nonpublic record on August 5, 2025; prehearing briefs and requests

to appear at the hearing must be filed with the Secretary to the Commission not later than 5:15 p.m. on August 11, 2025; the prehearing conference will be held at the U.S. International Trade Commission Building on August 13, 2025, if deemed necessary; parties shall file and serve written testimony and presentation slides in connection with their presentation at the hearing by no later than noon on August 14, 2025; the hearing will be held at the U.S. International Trade Commission Building at 9:30 a.m. on August 15, 2025; the deadline for filing posthearing briefs is 5:15 p.m. on August 22, 2025. In addition, any person who has not entered an appearance as a party to the investigations may submit a written statement of information pertinent to the subject of the investigations, including statements of support or opposition to the petition, on or before August 22, 2025.
