The meeting notice is also being amended to update the Matters to be Considered to read as

follows: The agenda will include discussions on anthrax vaccines, chikungunya vaccines, COVID-19 vaccines, influenza vaccines, measles, mumps, rubella, varicella (MMRV) vaccine, Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV) vaccines for maternal and pediatric populations, and an update on work groups. Recommendation votes are scheduled for influenza vaccines, and RSV vaccine for maternal and pediatric populations. A Vaccines for Children (VFC) vote is scheduled for RSV vaccines.

The Director, Office of Strategic Business Initiatives, Office of the Chief Operating Officer, Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, has been delegated the authority to sign *Federal Register* notices pertaining to announcements of meetings and other committee management activities, for both the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and the Agency for Toxic Substances and Disease Registry.
