### Presidential Declaration Amendment of a Major Disaster for the State of TEXAS

**AGENCY:** U.S. Small Business Administration.

**ACTION:** Amendment 1.

**SUMMARY:** This is an amendment of the Presidential declaration of a major disaster for the State of TEXAS (FEMA-4879-DR), dated July 6, 2025.

Incident: Severe Storms, Straight-line Winds, and Flooding.

**DATES:** Issued on July 10, 2025.

Incident Period: July 2, 2025 and continuing.

Physical Loan Application Deadline Date: September 4, 2025.

Economic Injury (EIDL) Loan Application Deadline Date: April 6, 2026.
