SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION: The Government of the Republic of Cameroon submitted a request to the Government of the United States on July 29, 2024, under Article 9 of the 1970 UNESCO *Convention on the Means of Prohibiting and Preventing the Illicit Import, Export and Transfer of Ownership of Cultural Property*. Cameroon’s request seeks U.S. import restrictions on archaeological and ethnological materials representing Cameroon’s cultural patrimony.
