Abstract: The VA will use the information collected to determine if a program in a foreign country is approvable under CFR 21.4260. In order for a review and decision to be made, the VA needs supporting information from a foreign educational institution. After completing the form, foreign institutions will continue to download the VA Form 22-0976 from the GI Bill website and submit it via email to federal.approvals@va.gov

An agency may not conduct or sponsor, and a person is not required to respond to a collection of information unless it displays a currently valid OMB control number. The *Federal Register* Notice with a 60-day comment period soliciting comments on this collection of information was published at 90 FR 27071, June 25, 2025.
