Foreign-Trade Zone 38; Application for Subzone; Elite Logistix, LLC; Rock Hill, South Carolina

An application has been submitted to the Foreign-Trade Zones (FTZ) Board by the South Carolina State Ports Authority, grantee of FTZ 38, requesting subzone status for the facilities of Elite Logistix, located in Rock Hill, South Carolina. The application was submitted pursuant to the provisions of the Foreign-Trade Zones Act, as amended (19 U.S.C. 81a-81u), and the regulations of the FTZ Board (15 CFR part 400). It was formally docketed on September 12, 2025.

The proposed subzone would consist of the following sites: Site 1 (1.27 acres) 1203 Galleria Boulevard, Rock Hill; Site 2 (2.89 acres) 335 E. Springdale Road, Rock Hill; Site 3 (3.67 acres) 2087 Williams Industrial Boulevard, Rock Hill; and Site 4 (3.60 acres) 2751 Commerce Drive, Rock Hill. No authorization for production activity has been requested at this time. The proposed subzone would be subject to the existing activation limit of FTZ 38.

In accordance with the FTZ Board's regulations, Juanita Chen of the FTZ Staff is designated examiner to review the application and make recommendations to the Executive Secretary.

Public comment is invited from interested parties. Submissions shall be addressed to the FTZ Board's Executive Secretary and sent to: ftz@trade.gov. The closing period for their receipt is **[INSERT DATE 40 DAYS AFTER DATE OF PUBLICATION IN THE FEDERAL REGISTER]**. Rebuttal comments in response to

material submitted during the foregoing period may be submitted through November 12, 2025.
