Wildfire Risk Mitigation Technical Conference; Notice Inviting Post-Technical Conference Comments

On Tuesday, October 21, 2025, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (Commission) staff convened a Technical Conference to discuss cost-effective best practices to reduce the risk of wildfire ignition from the Bulk-Power System.
