AGENCY: Forest Service, Agriculture (USDA).

ACTION: Notice; withdrawal

SUMMARY: The Forest Service is withdrawing its notice of intent to prepare an environmental impact statement for the Shoshone National Forest Travel Management project on the Shoshone National Forest. The Forest is withdrawing its Notice of Intent in order to compile and review information concerning access and travel management needs and may pursue further planning and analysis at a later time.
