Proposal to Extend the Cultural Property Agreement between the United States and Bolivia

SUMMARY: Proposal to extend the Memorandum of Understanding Between the Government of the United States of America and the Government of the Plurinational State of Bolivia Concerning the Imposition of Import Restrictions on Categories of Archaeological Material from the Pre-Columbian Cultures and Certain Ethnological Material from the Colonial and Republican Periods of the Plurinational State of Bolivia (“the Bolivia Agreement”).
