### **I. Background**

The Contract Work Hours and Safety Standards Act (Construction Safety Act (CSA)) (40 U.S.C. 3701 et seq.) requires the Secretary of Labor (Secretary) to consult with ACCSH in formulating standards under the CSA.

ACCSH operates in accordance with the Federal Advisory Committee Act (FACA), as amended (5 U.S.C. 1001, et seq.), and its implementing regulations (41 CFR 102-3 et seq.).

### **II. Meeting**

#### **ACCSH Meeting**

ACCSH will meet virtually from 9:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. ET on Tuesday, May 19th and 9:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. ET, on Wednesday, May 20th, 2026. The meetings are open to the public.
