Abstract: VA Form 26-6807, The Financial Statement information collection is used to determine a borrower's financial condition in connection with efforts to reinstate a seriously defaulted, guaranteed, insured, or portfolio loan. In addition, the form is used in determining the financial feasibility of a veteran or service member to obtain a home with the assistance of a Specially Adapted Housing Grant under 38 U.S.C., Chapter 21. The changes in burden and respondent estimates increased from the previous submission due to more accurate accounting of information conducted by VA Loan Technicians via telephone, which were previously underreported. The number of participating Veterans increased from 29 to 1,200.

An agency may not conduct or sponsor, and a person is not required to respond to a collection of information unless it displays a currently valid OMB control number. The *Federal Register* Notice with a 60-day comment period soliciting comments on this collection of information was published at 91 FR 8579, February 23, 2026.
